Mr. Derian continued to state that the expenditure line items were reviewed and the pending revenue line items were awaiting Federal and State funding.

Principal Bozios stated that she was pleased to announce that the Oradell Public School P.T.A. has committed financial (\$11,000) support to purchase 25 Chrome Books with a charging cart to enhance our technology initiative and with the help of the Oradell Rotary Club have secured financial support to purchase new high volume water fountains within the building.
