Care about my child




Family Survey: Areas of Concern


- ■School notifies me when a situation occurs to him/her as a victim (Q5)




- Students in my school are well behaved (Q7)




Students in my school try their best

HIB Self Assessment 15-16

- <u>www.oradellschool.org/osnj/OUR%20SCHOOL/Harassment%2C%</u> 20Intimidation%20and%20Bullying/HIB%20Self%20Assessment% 202015-2016.pdf
- Released to districts January 10, 2017; posted January 11, 2017
- District self-assesses in 8 core elements (26 sub elements)
- Baseline score of 52 means district is meeting requirements in all areas. Perfect score = 78
- Oradell scored 60 in 13-14, 64 in 14-15 and 66 in 16-17
- Strengths: HIBster software; collaboration amongst ABC, ABS and School Safety Team; new classroom read alouds & activities
- Areas for growth: Provide HIB guidance in internal memos (indicator 2); document meetings between ABC and ABS (indicator 5); post information about meaning of grades and their relationship to school self assessment (indicator 8)

- Physical appearance of school
 - Environment of school (safe and clean)
 - Pride in appearance of school
- Student behavior
 - Students treat each other, teachers and administrators with respect

 - Students care about learning
 - Students do not tease and bully each other

- Teachers collaborate with others




- Admin shows appreciation for efforts of staff (Q21)

- Parents collaborate with teachers to improve student performance (Q27)




Administration Shows Appreciation for the Efforts of the Faculty and Staff




I am hesitant to approach administration about my concerns/issues

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Room for Growth

- Better align questions for future "apples to apples" comparison
- 3 choices (agree, disagree, no opinion) versus 5 choices (strongly agree, agree, somewhat agree...)
- Parent question Q5- "school notifies me when a situation occurred...)
- Break out teachers vs. admins for students and teachers
- Better timing of implementation of survey and reminders to stakeholders to increase participation
- Define terminology
- Provide opportunities for open-ended response
