GIFTS TO SCHOOL PERSONNEL

The Oradell Board of Education discourages students, parents, classes, booster clubs, vendors, and others shall be discouraged from the presentation of personal gifts to district employees..

The board of education believes that the best expression of gratitude and appreciation for staff is written communications and encourages and welcomes such input.

When a student feels a desire to present a gift to a staff member, the gift should be inexpensive and/or homemade.

This shall not be interpreted as intended to discourage acts of generosity in unusual situations. Simple remembrances, expressive of affection or gratitude shall not be regarded as violations of this rule.
