D7. Approval of a Maximum Travel Expenditure for SY 2020-2021 –

WHEREAS, school district policy and N.J.A.C 6A:23a-7.1 et seq. provides that the Board of Education shall establish in the annual school budget a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for such travel and expense reimbursement for the SY 2020-2021; and

WHEREAS, maximum expenditure amount allotted for travel and expense for SY 2019-2020 was \$37,465; and

WHEREAS, travel and expense reimbursement has reached a total amount of \$23,993.50 as of March 18, 2020,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oradell Board of Education, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, hereby establishes the school district travel maximum for SY 2020-2021 at the sum of \$40,000 and.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to ensure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.
