Dear Families of Students in Grades 3-6,

In the spring, the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) requires that all public school students in grades 3-6 participate in the following 2023 State Assessments:

- New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA)
 - English Language Arts Grades 3-6
 - Mathematics Grades 3-6
 - Science Grade 5

On Friday, April 12, 2024, staff and students in grades 3-6 will participate in a New Jersey Student Learning Assessment 45-minute infrastructure trial to ensure our technology is functioning efficiently. Included in the trial is an audio assessment. Important note: please send in **wired** headphones for your child **before** the infrastructure trial on Friday. The same set of headphones will be used for the assessment dates below.

We prepare students for the NJSLA by teaching an approved curriculum aligned with New Jersey Student Learning Standards. We believe a strong curriculum, not isolated test prep, is the best way to prepare students for success. Teachers do familiarize students with testing procedures, typical test questions, and the testing website.

The schedule below outlines the days students at each grade level will be testing. Students will not be tested all day, and the daily testing period is approximately 60 to 90 minutes long, depending on the grade level and subject being assessed. Testing will be just one part of your child’s day. Students will attend their daily special (library, art, music, etc.), have lunch and recess, and continue to have instruction in the content areas. The testing period begins at 9 a.m. each day. **Students who arrive at school after testing begins will need to take part in makeup testing.**
