

Explorations will be conducted weekdays, Monday through Friday, beginning Tuesday, June 23rd and ending Friday, July 17th. *Explorations* will be closed on July 3rd. The attached schedule was devised so that children and parents may select as many as six courses from a variety of offerings. Session A will run from June 23rd - July 2nd and Session B will run from July 6th -July 17th. The tuition per course is \$70 during Session A and \$80 during Session B. Basic Skills classes are at a charge of \$120 for all four weeks.

Please complete the attached registration form for the appropriate session(s) and return it with a check reflecting full payment made payable to the Oradell Board of Education. The deadline for registration will be May 15, 2015 for both sessions. (All participants who register by the deadline will receive a commemorative t-shirt.) Please note, an additional \$25.00 non-refundable late registration fee per family will be charged for applications postmarked after May 15. No refunds will be given past June 5, 2015, and refunds requested prior to June 5 will result in a \$25.00 processing fee.


Sign Language
