Why is the Parent Portal so Important?

If you received weekly OPS email blasts last year, you know that we were diligently trying to meet the goal of having every OPS student registered in to the parent portal. The importance of this can NOT be OVERSTATED! The parent portal will serve as our link to OPS families moving forward. For example:

- Want to know about a snow day?
 Well, if your phone number isn't accurate in the parent portal, you won't get the call.
- Hate getting the call? Well, log in to the parent portal and choose to get a text or email instead.
- Want to know how your child is doing academically? Report cards will be accessed in the parent portal. <u>Paper report cards will be phased out during the 2014-2015 school year.</u>
- Are you a 6th grade parent who wants to keep tabs on how your child is doing academically on tests and assignments? The parent portal is your answer.
- MOST IMPORTANTLY --- Want your child to be dismissed from OPS? YOU MUST COMPLETE THE DISMISSAL FORM IN THE PARENT PORTAL. Starting on Wednesday, September 10th, students will not be dismissed without a parent or guardian picking them up IF we do not have a completed dismissal form for them.

Completing Forms in the Parent Portal

Four of the six **REQUIRED** Back-to-School forms must be completed electronically through Oradell Public School's Parent Portal! Each is located under the "Survey" section on

the left side of the portal. The forms are:

- Dismissal Form
- Parent/Student Handbook Sign off
- Media Release Form
- Computer Technology Contract You must fill the forms (all four) for <u>each</u> of your children. Please answer every question and most importantly, at the bottom, click SAVE and CLOSE when you are finished. By just clicking "Save", it will not submit the document.

The only other way to obtain the forms (paper copies) will be by visiting the main office.
