- Serve as an exceptionally skilled and dedicated educator;
- Play an active role in the school community;
- Have the respect and admiration of students, parents, administrators and colleagues.

All nominees will receive a letter stating that they were nominated, but the nomination forms will be kept confidential. If you wish to submit a nomination, it can either be sent electronically to EducatorOfTheYear@oradellschool.org or in paper form to the Main Office no later than December 11, 2017 by 3:00 pm. Please return all forms in a sealed envelope, labeled "OPS Educator of the Year - Nomination.
