Dear Parent/Guardian:

Please note the following information about Oradell Public School's Halloween celebration.

- <u>There will be one lunch period on Tuesday, October 31, 2017 from 11:15 a.m. until</u> <u>12:45 p.m. Return the form sent home to your child's teacher by Wednesday,</u> <u>October 18, 2017</u> indicating your child's lunch plans.
- Our student Halloween parade will be held on Memorial Field at 1:30 p.m. <u>fair weather</u> <u>only</u>. *Important note: to maintain a safe and enjoyable environment for all OPS children, please refrain from bringing dogs on the field during the parade.*
- <u>In the event of rain or other inclement weather we will not hold a Halloween</u> <u>parade.</u> Our students will enjoy classroom Halloween celebrations.
- All visitors to the school on Halloween, or any other day, must enter the school through the Main Entrance and sign in at the Main Office. <u>Only visitors who have a preapproved reason for visitation will be admitted</u>. In addition, <u>all visitors must be recognizable</u> (i.e. no masks or make-up that will prevent easy identification), and present proper identification if requested.
- <u>As in the past, we request that you not dress your children in costumes that are</u> <u>gruesome or gory</u>. Such costumes are unnerving to our younger students. *Children should also refrain from carrying toy guns, toy weapons, etc.*
