Dear Parents,

The State of New Jersey has ended its membership of the interstate consortium that produced the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) assessments. While the online platform will remain the same, the state's Mathematics and English Language Arts (ELA) assessments will no longer be called PARCC. Instead, the statewide assessments for ELA and Mathematics will be called the New Jersey Student Learning Assessments-ELA (NJSLA-ELA) and the New Jersey Student Learning Assessment-Mathematics (NJSLA-M). The 5th grade science test will continue to be called the New Jersey Student Learning Assessment - Science (NJSLA-S). Beginning Monday, April 8, 2019, New Jersey students in grades 3-8 and high school will begin sitting for the New Jersey Student Learning Assessments.

The schedule below outlines days students at each grade level will be testing at Oradell Public School. Students will not be testing all day, and the daily testing period is approximately 60 to 90 minutes long, depending on the grade level and subject being assessed. Testing will be just **one** part of your child's day. Students will attend their daily special (library, art, music, etc.), have lunch and recess, and continue to have instruction in the content areas.
