Dear Parent/Guardian,

The placement of children in classes for next year is a responsibility we take seriously. Teachers and administrators will spend countless hours considering the placement of all students for the 2019-2020 school year. Our ultimate goal is to create strong learning communities.

We ask that parents keep the following in mind:

- Refrain from requesting a specific teacher as individual teacher requests will not be honored. This includes telling your child's current teacher who you think would be best for your child.
- If you have already had an experience with a particular teacher with an older child, and would prefer a different experience for a younger sibling, please share that information. We understand that sometimes there is a preference for a different experience for a sibling.
- Please do not request to NOT be in a specific teacher's class if you have not had a prior experience with that teacher. Statements such as, "Based on what I have heard, I think <insert teacher name> would not be a good fit for my child" are not acceptable. Also, not appropriate is posting on social media sites, "My child is going into 2nd grade. Who's a good teacher?" Those posts get right back to teachers and creates bad feelings.

Please email your input to 2019placement@oradellschool.org. (Include your child's name in the subject line and separate emails for each of your children.) Please understand that your input is not required or expected. The staff knows your child and will place them with the knowledge they have. Do not email just to share that your child would do best with a warm, supportive teacher. All students do best in that environment. Additionally, please keep your email to less than 150 words.
