Yesterday, I sent an email out regarding the current protocols being followed at OPS to keep the community safe. In that letter, there was also information regarding technology needs to continue learning if the Department of Health advises us to close school for a period of time. Today, I visited all classrooms in grades 3-6 and handed out a technology agreement to allow parents in those grades to choose to bring a laptop home if school is closed. A copy of that agreement, which must be signed whether you choose to take a laptop home or not, can be found in your child's backpack (hopefully), <u>here</u> or on the front page of the OPS website.

Additionally, for families in grades K-2, we do not anticipate that your children will be asked to submit work digitally; however, they will need access to an internet capable device to visit specific websites where learning materials will be stored. As I shared with children today, we are just being prepared. We are not in crisis or overly alarmed at this time. We just believe that the best way to support our children now and in the future is to be ready for anything!
