This Halloween, once again, we will have one lunch period for grades K-6. The lunch period on this day will be from 11:30 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. This extended time will allow the children to eat and change into their costumes in a more manageable fashion. For just one day, we will dispense with signing children out and back in at lunch provided you sign and return the form below. Children must be picked up by the designated adult and may not go "downtown" for lunch unless accompanied by a parent or another designated adult. Our classroom teachers will dismiss children at the exits as they normally do at dismissal. Children will only be dismissed to the person listed below. Students who wish to stay at lunchtime may do so and will be supervised, as always. Please note that students should return to school no earlier than 12:50 p.m. Parents are responsible for supervising their children until the doors open. Kindergarten, first, second, and third grade students should line up at the door where they are usually dismissed.
