## Dear Families:

Please note the following information about Oradell Public School's 2021-22 Halloween celebration:

- There will be one lunch period on Friday, October 29, 2021 from 11:15 a.m. until 12:45 p.m.
- Students may stay in school to have lunch, recess, and dress in their Halloween costumes. If families prefer, students may return home for lunch and change into their costumes. Students need to be picked up at 11:15 a.m. and dropped off at 12:45 p.m. at their assigned grade level door.
- Please fill out this online form by Tuesday, October 26, 2021. One form needs to be filled out per child.
- There will be no community Halloween parade this year. However, students will be able
  to celebrate in costume with their classes. Weather permitting, class Halloween parties
  will be held outside. In the even of rain, student will enjoy classroom Halloween
  celebrations.
- Class parents should reach out to their teacher for the time and location of the class parties.
- All visitors to the school on Halloween, or any other day, must enter the school through the Main Entrance, sign a health attestation, and sign in at the Main Office. Only visitors who have a preapproved reason for visitation will be admitted. In addition, all visitors must be recognizable (i.e. no masks or make-up that will prevent easy identification), and present proper identification if requested. Masks must be worn inside the school building.
- As in the past, we request that you not dress your children in costumes that are gruesome or gory. Such costumes are unnerving to our younger students. Children should also refrain from carrying toy guns, toy weapons, etc. Additionally, students need to wear their health masks while in costume.
