- I. The meeting was **CALLED TO ORDER** at 7:30 p.m. by President Watson-Nichols.

# VI. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT/BOARD PRESIDENT'S REMARKS

Community Planning Report – the community planning committee is presenting their final report to the Board. The committee was divided into four sub-committees who reviewed the four over-arching goals and provided activities for these goals to be achieved. We thank all of the individuals who participated in this initiative and especially thank those who saw it to the end thus providing tonight's report.

January 2012 declared School Board Recognition Month – It is hereby moved by Dr. Westlake, seconded Mrs. Walker, upon recommendation of the Interim Superintendent, that the following resolution was unanimously approved by the Board:

- WHEREAS, The New Jersey School Boards Association and the National School Boards Association have declared January 2012 to be School Board Recognition Month, a time that all residents might acknowledge the contributions made by our local school board members; and
- WHEREAS, The Oradell Board of Education is one of 587 local school boards in New Jersey that sets policies and oversees operations for public school districts; and
- WHERAS, The Oradell Board of Education embraces the goal of high-quality education for all New Jersey public school students; and
- WHEREAS, New Jersey's local school boards help determine community goals for the education of 1.4 million children in pre-kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade; and
- WHEREAS, New Jersey's 4,800 local school board members, who receive no remuneration for their services, act as advocates for public school students as they work with administrators, teachers and parents for the betterment of public education; and
- WHEREAS, School boards strive to provide the resources necessary to meet the needs of all students, including those with special needs; and
- WHEREAS, Boards of education provide accountability to the public; they communicate the needs of the school district to the public; and they convey to school administrators the public's expectations for the schools; and
- WHEREAS, New Jersey can take pride in its schools, which rank among the nation's best in indicators such as high school graduation rates, class size, college entrance exam participation and Advance Placement offerings and test scores. Now, therefore be it
- **RESOLVED,** That the Oradell Board of Education, does hereby recognize the services of local school board members throughout New Jersey as we join communities statewide in observing January 2012 as SCHOOL BOARD RECOGNITION MONTH; and be it further
- **RESOLVED,** That the Oradell Board of Education urges all New Jersey citizens to work with their local boards of education and public school staffs toward the improvement of our children's education.

### Dr. Nuccetelli discussed the following items:

• Election Bill – The lame duck session of the Legislature passed bills in both Houses of the Legislature which would move the School Election to November at the same time as the General elections. Any district whose budget came in at or below the 2% cap would be exempt from a public vote. The November Election would only be to select the school board members for the district. Any separate questions which would exceed the 2% cap would still be subject to a public vote. Presently the bills have gone to the governor for him to sign. The bill would take effect immediately and if signed would eliminate the election in April. These bills would save the

- district the cost of an April election and a November Election would be less costly as the costs would be shared with the municipalities.
- All Day Kindergarten A committee has been formed after soliciting volunteers from the parent community and the staff to serve on it. The first meeting is set for Monday, January 16 at 4:00 pm. One of the tasks will be to design a questionnaire for the community to respond to giving their thoughts on implementing an all day kindergarten in September, 2012. In addition, the committee will establish a calendar including a public hearing at which the public can appear to state their feelings about this issue. The timeline for a recommendation to the Board is March 1, 2012.
- Stop and Shop Initiative OPS has earned over \$1,300.00 in this program. We thank the Oradell Community for their support. These monies will come to the district at the end of the year. Anyone can participate by registering their Stop and Shop card in the program under OPS.
- School Board Recognition Month January 2012 has been designated School Board Recognition Month in New Jersey. It is a time to raise public awareness of the roles and responsibilities of local boards of education and it is also a time for communities to thank their local school board members for their service.
